After a two year hiatus because of the pandemic, Trout in the Classroom (TIC) and its associated Release Day field trip returned to several local schools.

Blacklick Valley High, Conemaugh Township Middle, Divine Mercy Catholic Academy East and West, Forest Hills Middle, and Shade-Central City High are MLTU-supported schools that, in cooperation with the PA Fish and Boat Commission and PA Council of Trout Unlimited, raised rainbow trout fingerlings from eggs in a classroom aquarium before releasing them into a state-approved body of water. Students were responsible for the daily care and maintenance of the aquarium and its residents. Not only did they witness the amazing transformation through which fish go, but they learned the significance of coldwater resources and of the work countless organizations and individuals continue to do to protect and increase the number of coldwater fisheries in the region.
